Summary for April 2022

The Blackhawk and Valley Station Deputies either initiated or responded to the following calls for service:

- 432 ~ Total calls for service in Blackhawk
- 8 ~ Total police reports were taken in Blackhawk

There was 1 felony reported:

1. PC 487 (Grand Theft). A resident reported 3 handbags worth approx. \$3000.00 were missing from her residence. The victim's former housekeeper is suspected of the theft. The housekeeper was identified, and a crime report has been forwarded to Investigations Division for further follow up.

There were 2 misdemeanors reported in the district:

1. On 4/8/22, a female suspect walked out of Draegers with approx. \$200 worth of items without paying. The female was apprehended by loss prevention.
2. On 4/15/22, a male suspect concealed several bottles of "high end" wine in his pants and walked out of Draegers without paying. The male gave the bottles to an accomplice in a waiting vehicle and attempted to re-enter the store to make another theft. The suspect was apprehended by loss prevention.

Incidents of Interest

- There were 2 property damage vehicle accidents both involving drivers running into structures, at low speeds. In both instances drivers stated they accidentally depressed their gas pedals instead of the brake, causing them to strike the structure in front of their vehicle. The first occurred in the Plaza (Montessori School) and the second in the Medical Plaza across the street. There were no injuries in either accident.

Volunteers in Policing

- A new vehicle was delivered to the PD on May 2. The vehicle is not marked and is all white in color. The vehicle will be utilized for volunteer use. A meeting with all volunteers will be scheduled in the coming weeks to go over expectations and services that will be provided. Hopes are the program will resume as soon as next month.

Notes from the Chief of Police

- Blackhawk PD participated in the “National Prescription Drug Take Back” on April 30th. The event was very successful with residents turning over 81lbs of medication for destruction. Blackhawk led all stations participating throughout the county, except for Danville PD, which took in over 200lbs.

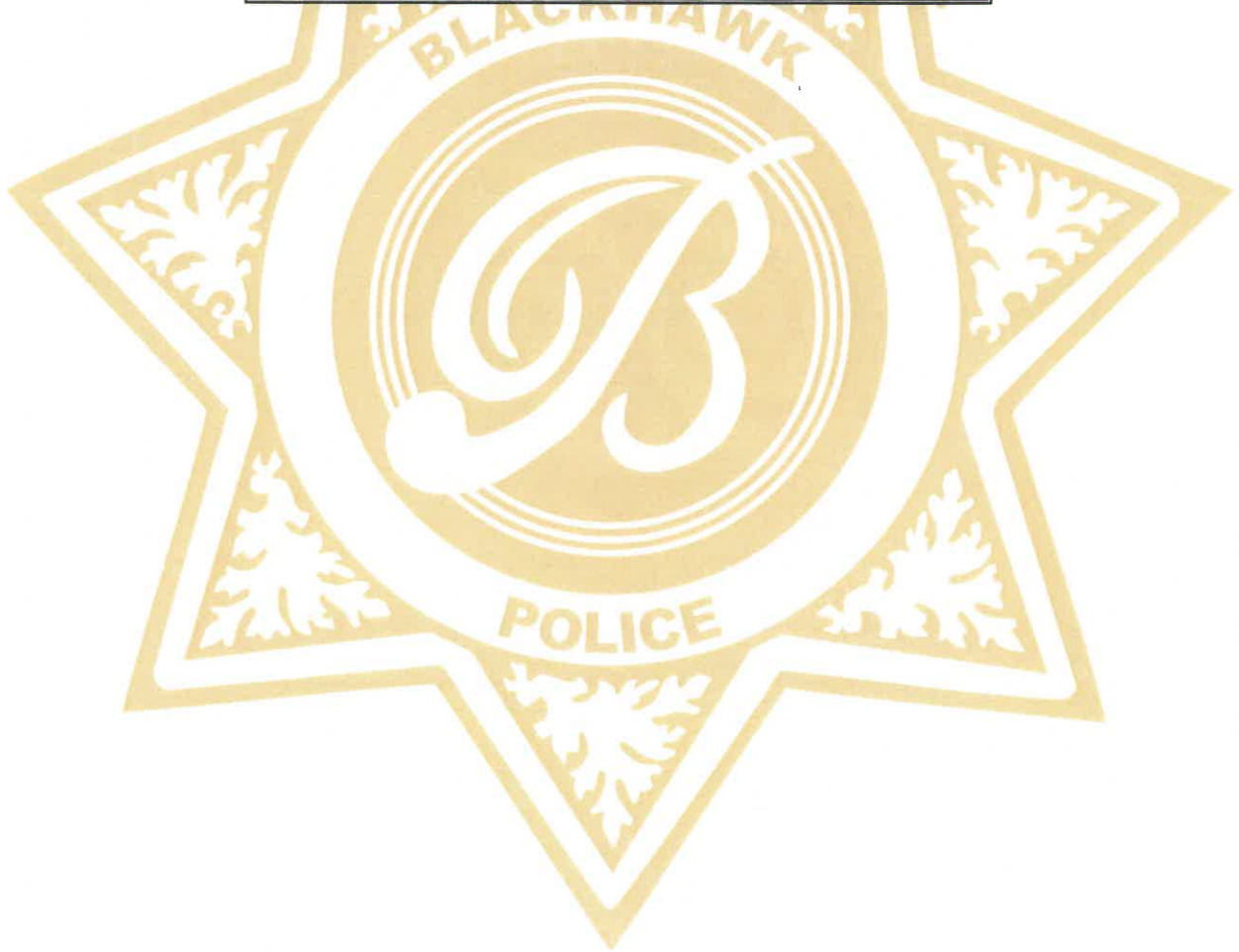
