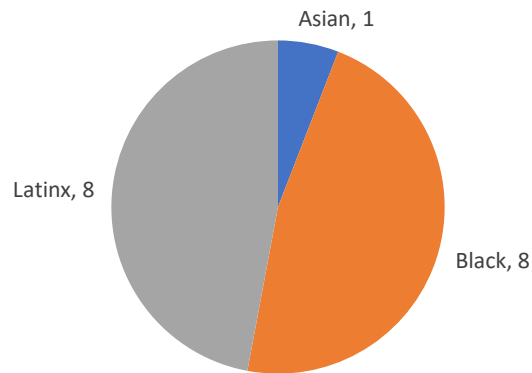

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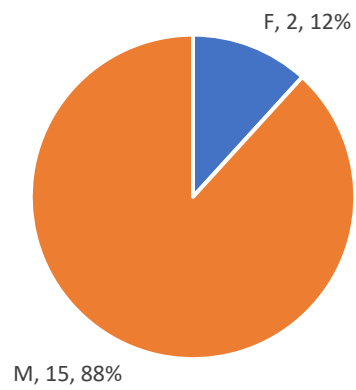
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Juvenile Intakes by Race / Ethnicity
(January '21 Intakes)



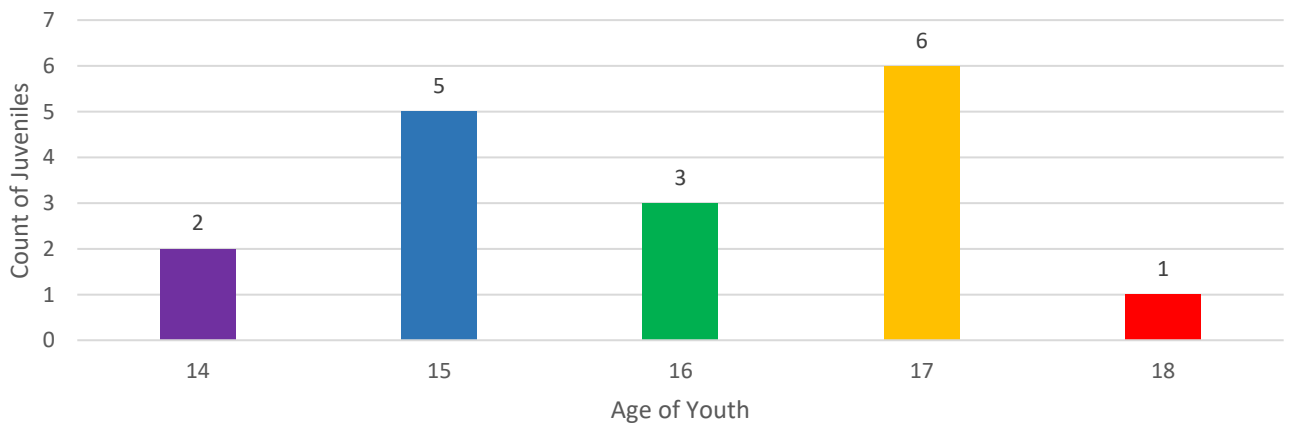
n = 17 intakes, 01/2021

(January '21 Intakes)

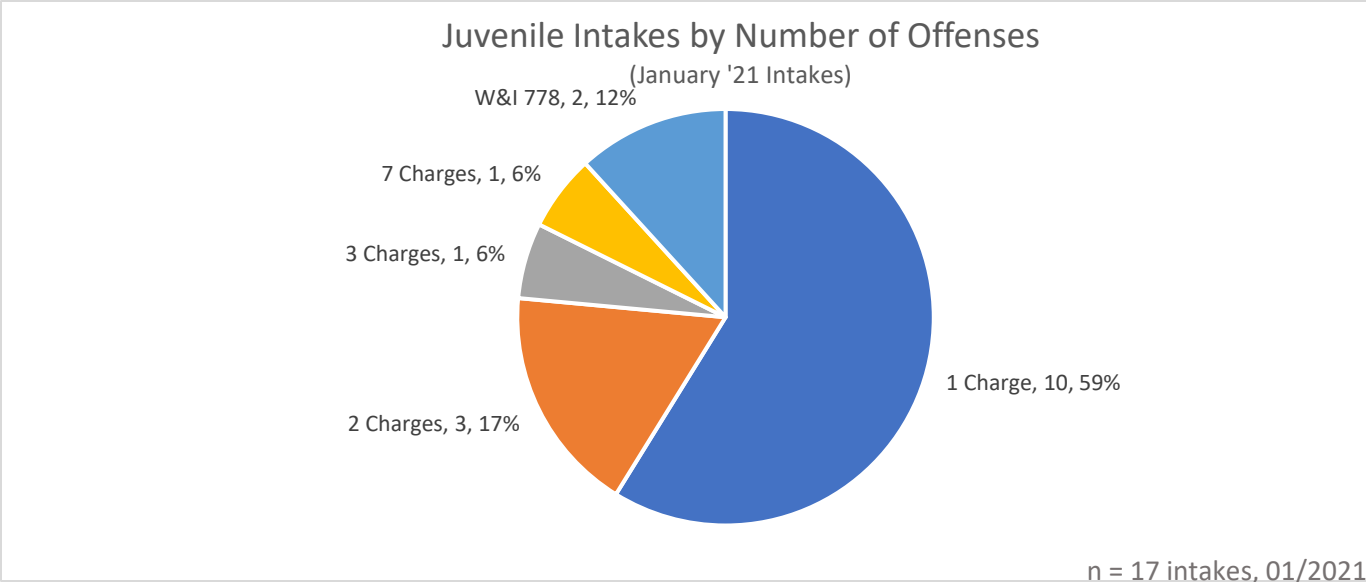
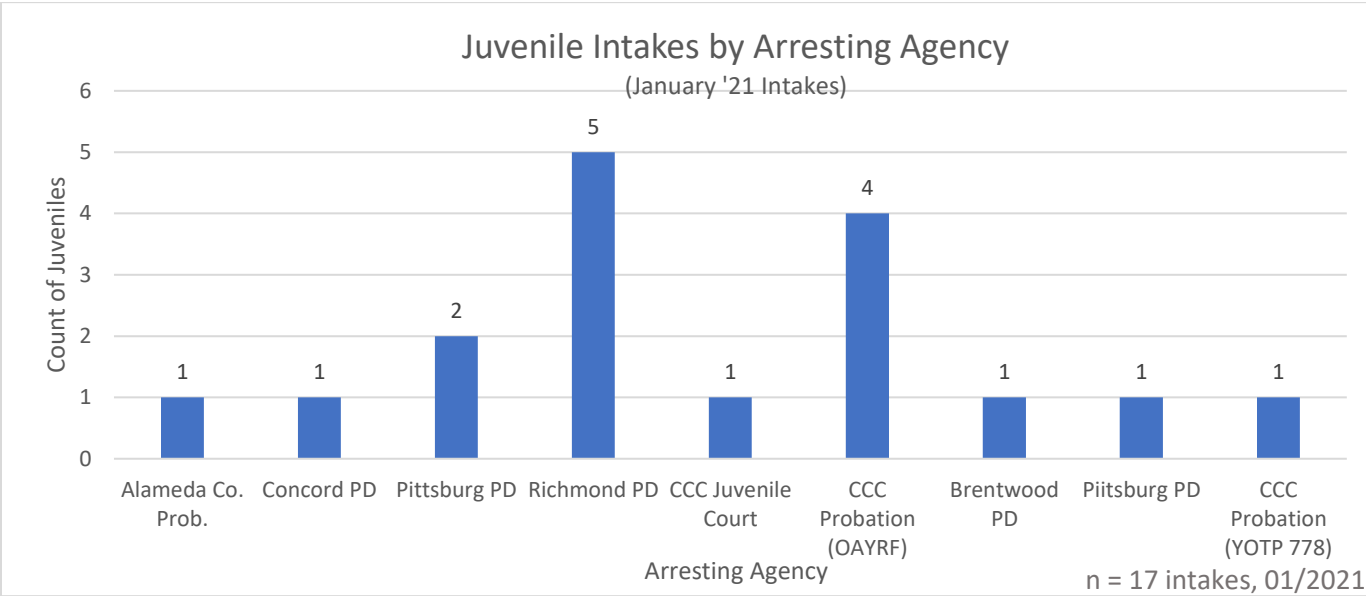
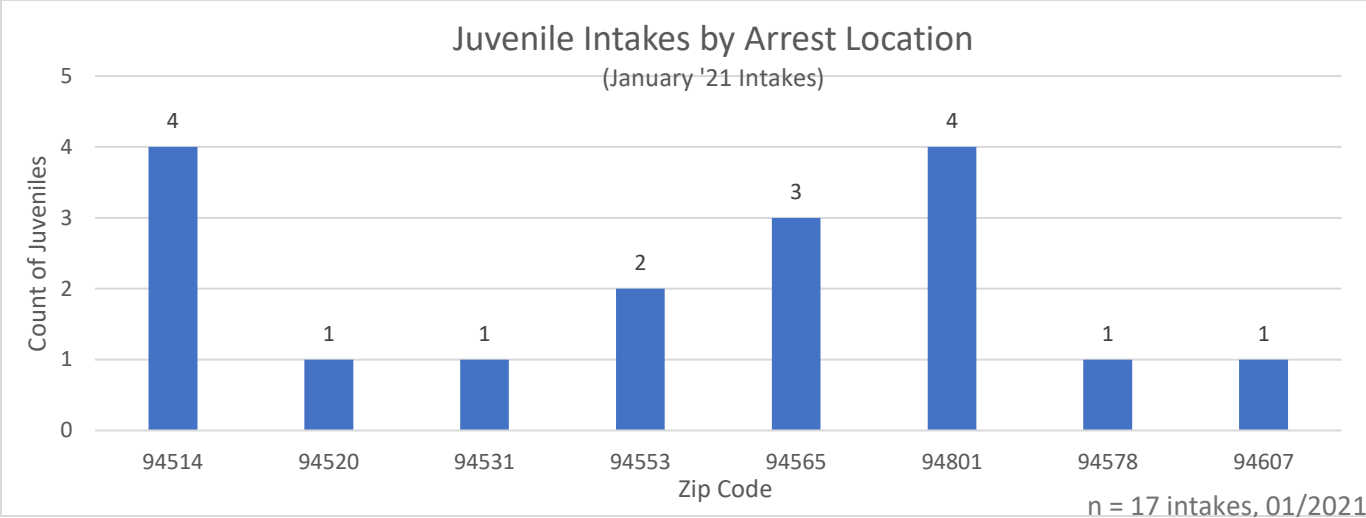


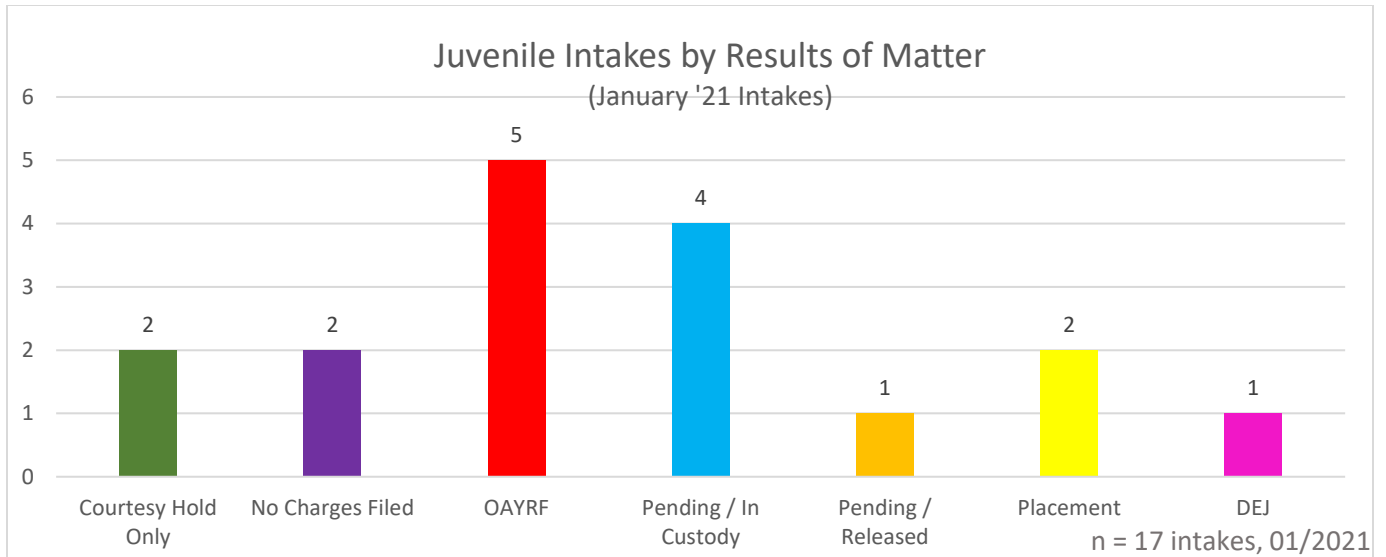

On average the number of days in custody prior to release was 12 days. (n = 13).

Among the youth who entered Juvenile Hall during the month of January, 2 youth entered County programs; 5 entered OAYRF and the other entered DEJ. The average number of days between decision to program entry was 26 days; 4 days, and 1 day, respectively.

NOTES:

Pending: The matter at hand has not yet been resolved. The youth may be in or out of custody awaiting a resolution.

No charges filed: No charges have been filed within 72 hours of arrest. Information on whether charges will be filed later or if the DA declines to file is not available.
