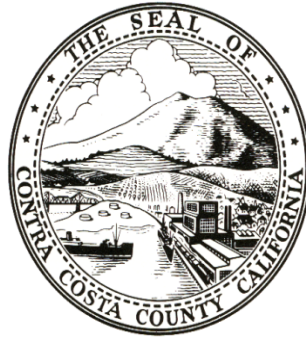

5. Agency Reports. The MAC received the following reports:

- a. **Supervisor Glover, Vincent Manuel** – Supervisor Glover was in another meeting so Vincent gave on COVID. The county will be updating our status to red soon, they are now giving vaccinations in Bay Point at the clinic at Riverview Middle. Residents are now being asked to go to My Turn, the state system to register for vaccinations. Lights are finally up on Pullman and Suisun and now we are waiting for PG&E to get power to

them. He also encouraged residents to continue to use the Mobile Citizen app to report issues in Bay Point.

- b. Contra Costa Sheriff – Lt. Gackowski**– Lt. Gackowski gave crime stats, residential burglary remain low, there was one in February and one auto burglary. Deputy Proctor added there had been an increase in vandalism and that Ambrose had opted to let the homeless use the parks which was created some issues.
 - c. Code Enforcement – Joe Losado** - Joe reported that they had opened 24 new cases, closed 89 and have 75 current cases. He expects things will pick up in the spring and they are once again short staffed.

 - e. Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that they continue with maintenance and the new main on Manor done. They will move forward with other capital improvements.
