c. **Code Enforcement – Armondo** – Armondo reported that they opened 11 new cases, closed 13 and have 67 active cases. They are in the process of hiring new staff.

d. **Contra Costa County Fire Protection District – Steve Hill** -Steve reported about the marsh fire that had started in Bay Point and continued into Pittsburg burning for several weeks until they doused it with 100 million gallons of water using pumps to

get it from the river. He also reported that they had a reorganization with the CCC Fire District which will benefit all with improved services. The new Fire Station 86 will be opening this month.
