There was a detailed conversation around the inmate welfare fund of the Sheriff, and the high telephone costs that are used to build the IWF. Conversation focused around proposed legislation to cut these fees, similar changes made to the costs of calls in the state prison system, and changes to fees for calls across state lines from local jails. Fees within the state from jail are now much higher than those out of state and include numerous hidden charges that make it difficult for families to stay in touch.
