*BSCC working on recidivism definition, and seems to be headed towards conviction or violation of supervision in lieu of prosecution; CCP bylaws conversation should be added to agenda*

*Healthcare group discussed medication policies and implementation of AB720 which is MediCal enrolment which was on BOS agenda this week*  
*SLE group discussed possible models for implementation with reference to RFI Marin County released; must research for the particular housing needs of the reentry population – should promote transition from structured environment to structured environment;*

- *DPC training for mentors has occurred, Management team now meeting and building network infrastructure with 10 mentors signed up and expecting 20 max setting date for full system rollout 10/1; Expect to have Dream Center to master lease units with up to 15 individuals.*

- *Hiring and Site Selection Committee has been formed which selected Director and Resource Coordinator, and will work to seat Steering Committee Members and help in site selection with negotiations breaking down on 23<sup>rd</sup> street site, negotiations continue with 2400 Macdonald, and 1500 Macdonald added as a new site.*
