Tree removal in riparian zone	Current Planning 925-674-7205
Plant appropriate ground covers/erosion control (recommended zorro fescu)	No permit required: Watershed Program 925-313-2236 or Flood Control Counterperson 925-313-2000
Plant any shrub, vine, or tree within a riparian corridor	Drainage 1010 Permit may be required 925-313-2000
Destroy or significantly alter riparian or bank-stabilizing vegetation	Drainage 1010 Permit may be required, Contact Flood Control 925-313-2000
Reporting fallen trees-Erosion/bank failures	Public Works-Maintenance 925-313-7000
If you witness illegal dumping	Call 911 and report all relevant details, include a license plate
