19. CHLORACNE or other acne form disease consistent with chloracne (must manifest to a degree of 10% within one year of exposure)
20. SOFT-TISSUE SARCOMA (other than osteosarcoma, chondrosarcoma, Kaposi's Sarcoma or mesothelioma) the term "soft-tissue sarcoma" includes the following
 - a. Adult fibro sarcoma
 - b. Dermatofibrosarcoma protuberans
 - c. Malignant fibrous histiocyoma
 - d. Liposarcoma
 - e. Leiomyosarcoma
 - f. Epithelioid leiomyosarcoma (malignant leiomyosarcoma)
 - g. Rhabdomyosarcoma
 - h. Ectomesenchymoma
 - i. Angiosarcoma (hemangiosarcoma and lymphangiosarcoma)
 - j. Proliferating (systemic) antioendotheliomatosis
 - k. Malignant glomus tumor
 - l. Malignant hemangiopericytoma
 - m. Synovial sarcoma (malignant synovioma)
 - n. Malignant granular cell tumor of tendon sheath
 - o. Malignant schwannoma, including malignant schwannoma with rhabdomyoblastic differentiation (malignant Triton tumor), glandular and epithelioid malignant schwannomas
 - p. Malignant mesenchymoma
 - q. Malignant granular cell tumor
 - r. Alveolar soft part sarcoma
 - s. Epithelioid sarcoma
 - t. Clear cell sarcoma of tendons and aponeuroses
 - u. Extra skeletal Ewing's sarcoma
 - v. Congenital and infantile fibrosarcoma
 - w. Malignant ganglioneuroma
